*Applicant Information for Optional Summer Awards*

The Oklahoma State Regents' Academic Scholars Program policy provides for optional summer term awards for students who meet the criteria outlined below. The award counts as one-half (1/2) of a regular academic semester and will count against the initial semesters of program eligibility. The award for a summer term is one fourth (1/4) of the annual award established for the institution the student attends. The award will be disbursed to the institution on the student's behalf after the application deadline of June 1, 2011.

**Eligibility for Summer 2011 Award**

Students must meet the following criteria for payment purposes:

1. The student must have earned a total of 24 semester credit hours during the fall 2010 and spring 2011 semesters combined. If the student was on a leave of absence for any portion of the 2010-11 academic year, he or she will be required to have earned twelve credit hours for each semester not on leave.
2. The student must be enrolled full-time (six semester credit hours) in a single higher education institution in the state of Oklahoma.
3. The student must have been admitted to a degree-granting undergraduate, graduate or professional program.

**Application Procedure**

Students who meet the above criteria should complete and sign the summer 2011 application. The application requires the signature of the Academic Scholars Program Coordinator or other institution official at the summer institution. This signature certifies that the student has earned at least 24 semester credit hours in the previous academic year and is enrolled full-time for the summer term.

The institution official must submit the completed application to the Oklahoma State Regents' office no later than June 1, 2011. *Applications received after this date will not be considered for payment.*

**Continuing Eligibility for Fall 2011 Award**

To be eligible for an award for the fall 2011 semester, students paid for the summer term must have earned a total of 30 semester credit hours for the fall 2010, spring 2011 and summer 2011 terms combined. In addition, the student must have earned a 3.25 cumulative grade point average and be enrolled full time for the fall 2011 semester (12 credit hours). To expedite payment of the fall award, it is important that any summer hours at a different institution be transferred to the student's home institution as soon as possible.
