

LOGIC

Leadership with Ongoing Guidance, Instruction and Curriculum

The LOGIC Model was developed by GEAR UP staff in 2005. The three main branches of LOGIC training are: Using Data to Improve School Success; Developing a Positive School Culture; and Enhanced Curriculum Development.

During the summer of 2012 LOGIC training is required all of GEAR UP School Districts. The training will focus on "Using Data to Improve School Success," and "Developing a High Performance Learning Culture."

Schools should select teams of five members to attend LOGIC. An administrator and four teachers representing the four core subjects should make up the LOGIC team from the school. An intensive focus and study of each schools site data and culture will take place during the seven summer training days. The study in detail will include EXPLORE, PLAN, ACT, CRT, EOI, college remediation and retention data of the school site.

The outcome that is expected is a plan to be developed by each team that will be instituted to improve performance data. The team will return in the fall for a one day follow-up session to discuss plans and implementation made to date.

***LOGIC is required in year one of the grant.** It will be offered again in year three. After year three, LOGIC may be available as needed.
