Activities:

- Departments such as Chemistry, Information Systems, Accounting, Finance, Social Work, Mathematics, and Computer Science have research/scholarly components as part of capstone/senior seminar courses. (Approximately 300 students)
- Many programs such as Marketing, Management, History, Safety Management, Environmental Management, and Technology have specific courses in which research/scholarly activity are included. (Approximately 150 students)
- Music and art students present recitals and shows as part of their capstone. (Approximately 20 students)
- Approximately 60 students present at department-wide or campus-wide research seminars. Another 300 or so present to a class.
- In 2008, we had 108 students involved in presentations at Oklahoma Research Day.
- NSU Undergraduate Research Day: A Celebration of Scholarly and Creative Activity involved 27 student researchers in 2007; as many as 47 have been involved in previous years.
- In 2009, the Research Day at the Capitol Sweepstakes Prize was awarded to Megan Dallas for her science research.
