Hobson Urges Hiatt to Support Presidents' Bond Plan; Offers to Consider Other Proposals Separately

Senate President Pro Tempore Cal Hobson Wednesday offered to rescue the Higher Education bond issue from a sea of unnecessary partisan politics by announcing he would consider each of the other unrelated issues included in Speaker Todd Hiatt's bond proposal on their own merits.

"If Speaker Hiatt honestly supports a bond issue for Higher Education, he should work to pass Senate Bill 745 quickly and address these other issues separately," Hobson said.

"Some of them may be worthy ideas and we welcome the opportunity to consider each of them individually. However, taken together, along with Speaker Hiatt's plan to re-open the list of projects funded by the bond issue, they could lead to its untimely death."

Hobson restated his position that the list of projects included in SB 745, which passed the Senate on a 47-0 vote Tuesday, is non-negotiable.

The Senate leader said the Speaker's assertion that his plan would "insure that capital projects are based on objective criteria" is a direct insult to the state's 24 college presidents and the State Regents for Higher Education.

"The plan in Senate Bill 745 was drafted by the college presidents and regents, who developed a mutually-accepted objective formula for determining the needs on each campus. Months of research went into the Presidents' bond proposal. There's no need to create an 'objective' list because we already have one. Re-opening that process could very likely start an avalanche of me-too politics that will bury the issue completely," Hobson said.

The Senate leader also repeated his stance on designating a second source for paying off the Higher Education bonds should lottery revenues come up short.

"The backup source of funding in Senate Bill 745 is any revenue available to Legislature for appropriation. That means should the Legislature ever need to use another source to the pay the bonds, it would have a myriad of choices. It was written that way because that will assure that the Regents get the lowest interest rate and save the state money. Limiting the resources available to be used as secondary funding sources will raise the interest rate and cost the state money," Hobson said.

The Lexington Democrat said Speaker Hiatt's plan is full of examples of log-rolling issues into a single proposal when those issues do nothing but insert politics into what, thus far, has been a clean process.

"Allowing Oklahoma State University to buyout Langston University's interests in Tulsa has absolutely nothing to do with whether there are leaking roofs and overcrowded classrooms on college campuses from Miami to Altus," Hobson said.

Hiatt's assertion that his plan will end the diversion of money from the leaking underground petroleum storage tank clean-up fund to pay for capital projects at OU and OSU is misleading, Hobson said.

In 2002, the Legislature voted to redirect a portion of the revenue designated for storage tank clean-up to pay for the construction of a state-of-art weather research center at the University of Oklahoma and cutting-edge research facilities to study defenses against bio-terrorism at Oklahoma State University.

"But that so-called diversion is already scheduled to end early next year and all of the revenue will once again be available for use in cleaning up leaking underground petroleum storage tanks. Whether excess funds from a special 1-cent gasoline tax should be used to pay for bridge and road maintenance is another issue unrelated to the capital needs of our colleges and universities. It should be considered separately," Hobson said.

Hobson admitted he's skeptical about some of Hiatt's proposals.

He said he thinks Hiatt's plan is headed down a "slippery slope" by allowing the University of Oklahoma and Oklahoma State University to issue debt without legislative approval.

"For the last two years, Representative Hiatt fought to keep Oklahomans from getting to vote on a state lottery, a tribal gaming proposal and an increase in the cigarette tax. He always said he was sent to the Legislature to make those decisions for the people.

"Now that he's Speaker, he wants to abdicate all legislative responsibility and allow the state's two largest universities to go into debt on their own. I believe the public sent me here to keep an eye on its money, but if Speaker Hiatt honestly wants to explore that option we should do so independent of the bond proposal now on the table," Hobson said.

Hobson said the Speaker's suggestion that OU and OSU issuing bonds on their own, or regional universities drawing on a "bond bank," would get lower interest rates than the state as a whole is just not true.

"The full faith and credit of the State of Oklahoma is what will ensure the lowest possible interest rates for a Higher Education bond issue," he said. "But all of these things are issues that we should consider individually and none of them should be used to delay passage of the Higher Education bond proposal developed by our college presidents."

“Promise of Excellence” Higher Education Plan

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OKLAHOMA CITY (February 22, 2005) -- House Speaker Todd Hiatt today announced a bold \$500 million capital improvements bond package, which also will reform the way colleges finance capital projects for many years into the future.

Calling it the “Promise of Excellence” Hiatt said the plan is a comprehensive reform package that will forever change the way the state’s colleges and universities tackle capital improvements. “By fixing the system, we’ll avoid a crisis mentality in the future,” said Hiatt.

Hiatt and Rep. Tad Jones said the Promise of Excellence plan will also signal businesses outside the state that Oklahoma is serious about addressing the education needs of students for the new century and beyond.

Hiatt (R-Kellyville) and Jones (R-Claremore) said they embraced many of the general outlines of the higher education capital bond issue supported in recent weeks by Governor Brad Henry and Senate President Pro Tempore Cal Hobson. But Hiatt and Jones pointed out the proposed Henry/Hobson capital bond issue only offers a temporary fix that ignores widespread concerns about the long-term challenges facing the state’s higher education system.

“We trust the regents and presidents of our colleges and universities to identify capital needs,” said Rep. Jones, chair of the House Appropriations and Budget subcommittee on education. “With our plan, we’ll establish a businesslike approach to those needs.”

Hiatt and Jones said the Promise of Excellence plan would enact six major reforms:

Insure that capital projects are based on objective criteria

- Any capital projects at Oklahoma’s colleges and universities should be based on objective decisions made on the basis of growth, enrollment figures and the amount of research.

OSU Tulsa degree offerings.

- The Promise of Excellence plan will direct the State Regents for Higher Education to allow Oklahoma State University to offer expanded degree programs on the Tulsa campus – a significant first for the state.

Returning funds to the Petroleum Storage Tank Fund.

- In recent years, funds were diverted from Oklahoma’s Petroleum Storage Tank Fund to finance capital improvements at OU and OSU.

- The Promise of Excellence will stop this practice, while also giving colleges and universities the money they need.

- Motor fuel taxes provide revenue for the Petroleum Storage Tank Fund. Any surplus funds from the Petroleum Storage Tank Fund will go toward road and bridge maintenance for the Oklahoma Department of Transportation.

Permanent financing structure for future capital needs. “We will revolutionize capital spending decisions at Oklahoma’s colleges and universities, improving flexibility and reducing the cost of financing for infrastructure,” said Hiatt.

- The Promise of Excellence plan will allow OU and OSU regents to issue debt on their own, with the approval of the State Regents for Higher Education.
- At the same time, regional colleges and universities will have access to a capital endowment fund offered by the State Regents.

Plan for a secondary revenue source to pay for bond issue.

- To ensure that the bond issue can be paid for in years to come, the Promise of Excellence plan will identify the state’s gross production tax as a secondary source of revenue.

Terms will match the life of a project.

•The Promise of Excellence plan will place common sense boundaries around capital debt, allowing for variable financing for projects such as the purchase of furniture, computers and software upgrades. “It’s simply not good business practice to issue 30-year debt on things like computers and landscaping,” said Hiatt. The current Henry/Hobson plan finances short-term items like computers and furniture over a long period of 30 years.

“Helping our state’s colleges and universities be the best in the nation is an issue that surpasses party lines,” said Rep. Susan Winchester, R-Chickasha, Speaker Pro Tempore of the House.

“For too long, our higher education institutions have been forced to rely on a process controlled by the whims of lawmakers at the statehouse – a process governed by crisis, politics and often by pork barrel spending,” said Hiatt.

“We want to empower Oklahoma’s colleges and universities,” said Jones. “Our plan seeks to permanently fix the problem, to take politics out of the process and to give Oklahoma’s higher education leaders the ability to break new ground.”

Hiatt and Jones agreed with Governor Henry’s assessment that any bond issue should avoid pork barrel spending.

“We spent many weeks gathering input from business and community leaders across the state, consulting with experts in bond financing, to develop a comprehensive solution that will truly address the concerns of our state’s higher education system for the next century,” said Hiatt. “With student enrollment at record levels, we must give our colleges and universities more control over their own destiny. This plan accomplishes that.”
