## ***Highlights This Week:***

### **Legislature's time running out**

#### **Major issues must be decided within 2 weeks.**

OKLAHOMA CITY -- It's crunch time for the Oklahoma Legislature, with only two weeks left in the 2005 session and major issues -- including workers compensation and tort reform, tax cuts and the details of a \$5.9 billion state budget -- yet to be resolved.

"We're still on track for a smooth adjournment, provided we can reach agreement with the governor's office and the Senate leadership on some of the major issues," said House Speaker Todd Hiatt, R-Kellyville.

House and Senate leaders have told their respective members to be ready to work the next two Fridays, stretching the regular four-day legislative week into five days.

Negotiations are said to be close on workers compensation reform.

However, the only certain thing is that the session will end -- because it must -- by 5 p.m. May 27.

Hiatt says that before final budgets can be written for more than 80 state agencies, leaders need to hammer out the fine points of any tax cuts they can agree to, because those will affect the budget.

"You have to have some agreements in place before you can move the budget," he said.

Gov. Brad Henry said he expected a package of tax cuts to be approved.

"I'm not exactly sure which ones at this point," he said. "There's been no agreement as to which ones will be in a final package."

Tax cut proposals being considered fall into three general categories.

Henry wants to use \$200 million in anticipated surplus revenues to give Oklahomans \$100 million in income tax rebates and use the rest as seed money for a \$1 billion research endowment. Under his plan, taxpayers would also receive rebates during future years when there are excess funds.

House Republicans favor a plan that would give rebates the first year, then reduce the state's top 6.65 percent income tax rate to 6.25 percent. The Oklahoma Tax Commission estimates that would cost about \$108.2 million for fiscal year 2007.

Senate Democrats say that gradually increasing the state's standard income tax deduction to the federal level is a better way to help low- to middle-income taxpayers.

Oklahoma's standard deduction is capped at \$2,000 for all but married couples filing separately, for whom it is \$1,000. For tax year 2004, the federal deduction ranged from \$4,850 for single filers or couples filing separately to \$9,700 for married couples filing jointly.

The Tax Commission says that, although this proposal would cost only \$24.8 million in fiscal year 2007, its price tag would balloon to \$252.6 million for fiscal year 2009.

An estate tax exemption for collateral heirs, a corporate capital gains tax exemption, a sales tax holiday and a greater tax exemption for retirement income are also on the table. At one point in the negotiations, state leaders had decided to limit the impact of any additional tax breaks to \$63 million.

Although at least one joint budget subcommittee has hit a snag because of a disagreement over the Oklahoma Attorney General's Office using consumer protection funds for an end-of-life care task force, legislative leaders say that in general other budget talks are going well.

"Our subcommittees have had very productive meetings," said Senate President Pro Tem Mike Morgan, D-Stillwater. "It looks like it's coming together."

Morgan said one major issue that has taken a back seat in recent weeks is tort reform. He said the push for workers compensation reform, including Lt. Gov. Mary Fallin's recent takeover of the Senate to push for a procedural vote, has taken a lot of time and effort away from issues such as tort reform.

Morgan said this year has been the opposite of 2004, when lawsuit reform was a top issue.

"Any time we get to sine die (adjournment), there are always a number of things that just didn't get done that you talked about or wanted to get done," Morgan said. "We're going to keep pushing, but certainly workers comp is our priority at this point."

Morgan said leaders also need to come up with an agreement on how to fund Oklahoma's substantial road and bridge maintenance needs.

Lawmakers also face hundreds of other pieces of legislation on which members have labored long and hard all session.

Together with scores of budget measures, these single-issue bills bring the total number of surviving measures to around 600. This total includes bills in conference and many on which joint conferences have been requested, but not yet granted.

"Many of those bills will never be brought to the floor, never be signed out of conference committee," Morgan said. "The authors have decided to do something different, or they've not been able to reach the compromises they were working on to get a title back on a bill. There may be a number of reasons."

Hiatt said House members are not moving enough measures out of conference at this point.

"We're scheduling them for the floor as fast as they're coming to the floor leader's office," he said.

There is plenty of time to hear a substantial amount of legislation, Hiatt said, but it has to come out of conference first.

Henry said he expects that when the curtain rings down on this session, in addition to a tax cut, state leaders will have crafted an affordable prescription drug plan, an education reform and accountability plan, found funding to continue the commitment to raise teacher pay to the regional average and agreed on a comprehensive workers compensation reform measure.

"I think there's still time," he said. "Nobody's given up. Nobody's walked away."
