## 2010 Voter Registration Contest September 13-17, 2010

### *Contest Rules*

- One winner will be determined for each of the three institutional categories, Red, White, and Blue (see next page), based on the percentage derived by comparing the number of **student voters** registered to enrollment. Institutional categories are based on the criteria used for Oklahoma Campus Compact membership dues. Each winner will receive a plaque from Oklahoma Campus Compact presented by the president to the campus contest coordinator and student representatives.
- Voter registration drives **must** be held on **September 13-17, 2010** and **can only take place on college/university campuses**. Voter registration drives can be organized by individual students or campus student organizations. Registration conducted by outside groups will not count toward the contest.
- Although campuses are encouraged to continue to register students to vote until the October 8, 2010 state deadline for participation in the 2010 General Election as part of the 2010 Campus Vote Initiative, only registrations made and reported during the week of the Contest will count toward the Contest results.
- Voter registration totals are due to OkCC by fax by 5:00 p.m. on Monday, September 20, 2010. Each campus must use the official submission form signed by the Student Affairs Vice President or Dean of Student Affairs (form will be provided). One winning campus for each of three categories will be announced on Tuesday, September 21, 2010.
- "Registered voters" will be counted as college/university students who have fully completed a voter registration card and submitted it to the campus voter registration volunteers. The following categories will be counted as a registration:
  - **First time registration**
  - **Change of voting precinct**
  - **Change of party affiliation**
- Each campus is responsible for submitting completed registration cards to the Oklahoma State Election Board or to its County Election Board. *The State Election Board requests that the forms be submitted on a daily basis. If you choose to submit them all together, remember to complete this at the end of the week. Registration cards must be received by the State or County Election Board by 5 p.m. Friday, October 8<sup>th</sup> in order for new registrants to vote in the November 2, 2010 General Election!* **Information:** [http://www.ok.gov/elections/Voter\\_Registration/](http://www.ok.gov/elections/Voter_Registration/)
