2011 Voter Registration Contest Winners

Students, staff, and faculty from three institutions were presented awards for besting their fellow institutions in registering students to vote in the 2011 Oklahoma Campus Compact Voter Registration Contest. 13 campuses participated in the one-week contest, which was the 8th year the Voter Registration Contest has been sponsored by Oklahoma Campus Compact. The competition groups institutions with similar-sized full-time enrollments.

1,405 students were registered to vote in this off-election year. Almost 20,000 students have been registered to vote since the Voter Registration Contest began in 2003.

Eastern Oklahoma State College won the small institution category for the third time since the contest's inception, registering 87 students, or 5.7% of its enrollment. Students Jessi Collins, Will Davenport, and Jessie Lowrimore were accompanied by Karen Harrison and Brenda Kennedy of the administration.



Rogers State University was a first-time winner in this contest for the middle-sized institution category, with 112 students registered, or 3.5% of its enrollment. RSU's award was accepted by student Brandon Irby and Candice Nivison of the administration.

The large institution award was carried by the University of Central Oklahoma for the second straight year with 627 students registered to vote, or 4.9% of its enrollment. In the award ceremony UCO was represented by students Matt Sutter, Jennifer Pearsall, Sergio Arandas, and Danielle Hernandez, and William Radke, Mary Carver, Janelle Grellner, Jan Hardt, Dana Jackson, Will McCormick, and President Don Betz of the administration and faculty.
