### **Itinerary:**

China Today gives students an opportunity to visit one of the world's oldest countries.

Students will start the trip in Beijing and visit the Forbidden City, Coal Mountain and North Sea Park. From there, students travel to the Great Wall and the Underground Ming Tombs.

Educational opportunities abound when students visit Peking University and Summer Place. Visits to The temple of Heaven and Tiananmen Square precede the trip southwest to Xi'an. From there, the trip takes students southward toward Guangzhou, with stops to see the Terra Cotta Soldiers' Tomb and tombs of the Han and T'ang Dynasties. A Pearl River cruise and morning train to Hong Kong rounds out the trip before students return to Oklahoma.
