Southeastern Oklahoma State University was established in 1909 as a normal school to educate teachers for Oklahoma's public schools. Since that time, the university has added disciplines to become a comprehensive regional university. The university offers 41 undergraduate and nine graduate degree programs through the School of Arts and Sciences, John Massey School of Business, School of Education and Behavioral Sciences, and School of Graduate and University Studies. Diverse program offerings include teacher education, aviation, and occupational safety and health, to name just a few. In 2009, the John Massey School of Business earned initial accreditation in business from AACSB International – The Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business. Southeastern is one of only four universities in Oklahoma accredited by AACSB, and the only regional university in the state with that distinction. Both the undergraduate and MBA degrees at Southeastern received the AACSB accreditation. In addition to the main campus at Durant, programs are offered at the Southeastern-McCurtain County branch campus; Ardmore Higher Education Center; Eastern Oklahoma State College-McAlester campus; Tinker AFB and Oklahoma City Community College; and Grayson College in Denison, Texas.
