

## RESOLUTION

### OKLAHOMA STUDENT ACTIVITIES TRANSCRIPT

**WHEREAS**, The Oklahoma Student Government Association, at its General Conference in March 1996, passed resolution #96-8, "A Resolution To The State Regents For Higher Education To Facilitate The Establishment Of An Official Activities Transcript At All State Funded Institutions Of Higher Education"; and,

**WHEREAS**, The Student Advisory Board proposed in December 1996 that the Oklahoma System of Higher Education adopt a student activities transcript for the benefit of all Oklahoma students; and,

**WHEREAS** The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education and the Student Advisory Board requested that the Council on Student Affairs assist in the development of a student activities transcript model via a classroom project; and,

**WHEREAS**, The University of Oklahoma, Oklahoma State University, and Cameron University all presented student activities transcript models to the Council on Student Affairs in December 1998; and,

**WHEREAS**, The Council on Student Affairs recommended in February 1999 that the model developed by the students of the University of Oklahoma serve as the State System prototype.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Student Advisory Board to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education:

1. That the Oklahoma Student Government Association encourages the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education to support the Oklahoma student activities transcript proposal as outlined by the Council on Student Affairs.
2. That the Oklahoma Student Government Association encourages the State Regents to urge institutions to implement a web-based transcript program that can be easily used by students to track leadership activities, professional or education experience, honors, awards, scholarships and recognition, student employment, and organizational participation.
3. That the Oklahoma Student Government Association is committed to the success of a system-wide student activities transcript, and will work diligently at each campus to ensure its implementation and utilization.
